

CV OF JULIAN MANN

1. I, Julian Mann, am a member of the Institution of Civil Engineering Surveyors (MCInstCES) and an Associate of the Royal Institution of Chartered Surveyors (AssocRICS).
2. I graduated from Nottingham Trent University in 1998 as a Bachelor of Engineering with an upper 2nd class (2:1) degree in Engineering Surveying. This qualification includes Land and Precision Engineering Surveying, and involved a year surveying in Kuwait for the route of a 50km pipeline.
3. I worked for David J Powell Surveys Ltd (DJPSL), as a land surveyor, for three years (1998 to 2000) during which I gained experience in the specialism of boundary demarcation and boundary dispute resolution under the direct supervision of David Powell.
4. I then spent 15 years working (2001 to 2016) in the construction industry, progressing from a setting-out and precision alignment engineer, through to overall site management and finally up to contract management. Throughout my career I have specialised in precise data collection and on-site positioning with regard to high-specification projects.

As a contract manager I was able to develop and enhance my "people skills" that began in my early years at DJPSL and frequently had to deal with (and overcome) problems involving site personnel, ancillary tradespersons and the owners/occupiers of neighbouring properties. It was also necessary to keep accurate records (both written and photographic) and write reports on critical parts of each contract.
6. I have now returned to DJPSL where I intend to consolidate my preferred career path in Boundary and Right-of-Way Demarcation.
